DCIS conference is an international annual event organized since 1981. We are working hard to make the conference an unforgettable scientific and social experience.

The conference on Design of Circuits and Integrated Systems (DCIS) is an international meeting for researchers in the highly active fields of micro- and nano-electronic circuits and integrated systems. It provides an excellent forum to present and discuss works on the emerging challenges offered by technology, in the areas of modeling, design, implementation and test of devices, circuits and systems.

In its continuous intention of improving the discussion possibilities among junior and senior researchers, this year the **8th edition of the PhD Poster Competition** is scheduled. Apart from Poster displaying during all the conference, PhD Students could explain briefly their research advances and discuss with the conference attendees during coffee breaks. The student with the highest score on the poster and the discussion will receive an award, present their work at the closing session of the conference and have the opportunity of including a 6-pages paper in the IEEE Xplore proceedings of the conference.

All topics related to the conference's scope are welcome. Research projects should be original, not previously published in conferences or journals, and will be included in the PhD Forum proceedings.

PhD Students are encouraged to submit a **1-page .pdf file in Pentachart format** (template available at the conference webpage) by May 17th, 2026. Submissions must be sent using the *EasyChair* link (<https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=dcis2026>) and selecting "PhD competition" as topic.

Accepted works will be required to submit an abstract (IEEE single-spaced, double column, A4 page, 2 pages maximum) by September 20th, to be published in the Conference Proceedings.
